Having obtained a Bachelor of Sciences degree in Biology from Morehouse College, Rev. McKindra went on to study at the Phillips School of Theology at the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, GA where he received several distinctions for theological scholarship including The Bishop Thomas L Hoyt, Jr. Theological Scholarship Award and the Taggart Honor Award.

Prior to committing himself to the Hurts Chapel family, Rev. McKindra served congregations in Ruston, LA, Columbus, GA, Tacoma, WA, and Blytheville, AR. During his tenure in Ruston, Rev. McKindra was celebrated for bringing to bear commitments to civic engagement, pastoral care, and intellectual voracity. As pastor of the Mays Chapel CME Church congregation, in Ruston, Louisiana, partnerships with Louisiana Tech University, Grambling State University, Ruston NAACP chapter, local Graduate Fraternal and Sorority organizations, Ruston Voters League, and the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance all thrived.

While stationed in Tacoma, WA in June of 2007, Rev. McKindra was lauded for both his enthusiasm and sermonic proficiency. In living a life of ministry, Rev. McKindra actively led in advocating for justice on behalf of the marginalized. He served on the Board of Trustees for the Broadway Center for Performing Arts, co-chaired the newly initiated Tacoma Responsible Developers Religious Workgroup, and was honored as a 2009 Business Masters Exchange Club of Pierce County Book of Golden Deeds Honoree and a 2010 Maxine Mims Academy Community Volunteer Honoree. As Methodist itinerancy would have it, he continues these commitments in his new assignment in Olive Branch, MS.

Rooted in the word of God, Rev. McKindra seeks to develop relationships with Christ in two tongues: one trained on discerning the will of God in our lives right now, the other on communicating that will in ways that might resound.

As a servant to a living God, one who is actively moving and responding to the challenges of a post-modern world, Rev. McKindra encourages all that would hear him to recognize and react to cultures both high and low, to strive toward intellectual curiosity and soundness, and to see those dreams placed on our hearts fulfilled.
